Resurrection Sunday Flowers

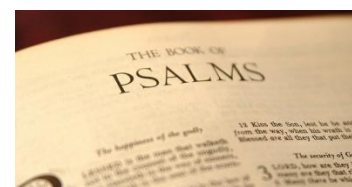

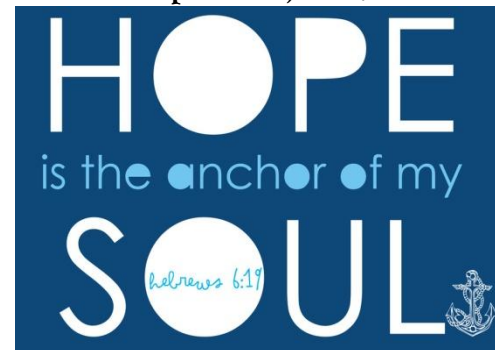
