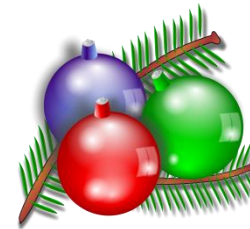

Finally, blessings of every kind are deposited in him; let us draw from his treasury, and from no other source, until our desires are satisfied.”
